Any member who wishes to move a resolution at the AGM must notify the Operations Manager by the 17th of September 2025. Nominations for Executive Committee are required to be in the hands of the Office Manager no later than 17th September 2025. These can be submitted via Julie in the office as Honorary Secretary and they will be passed to the Executive at that meeting.

Nomination forms are available from the office and by email on request. They must be signed by a proposer, a seconder and the nominee to show they are willing to be proposed. The Executive consists of the Chair, the Secretary, the Treasurer, and up to 8 other members.

All other members must be financial to vote, be nominated, to nominate another member or speak at the AGM. Nominations may be accepted at the AGM at the discretion of the Chair. A quorum for any General Meeting is 15 members personally present.

Any member is able to appoint another financial member or the Chairman of the meeting to vote on their behalf. Such a proxy shall be notified in writing to the Secretary not less than 24 hours prior to the meeting time.

Proxy forms are also available from the office, or by email, on request.

For the health and continuity of the WSA it is important that we have a good attendance and the participation of members. Those proposing to be on the committee are expected to attend regular meetings (usually monthly), unless poor health or other urgent business prevents them from doing so. Executive members are also expected to be in the office and in touch with the WSA Operations Manager on a regular basis during term time. Sub-committees are intended to organise tasks that WSA carries out, and executive members are expected to be involved in these as needed, alongside other members, and to report back to, and facilitate liaison with the executive.


