- 12-17 year old's day sculpting workshops: 14 - 17 April, 9am -12pm \$190 per young person.

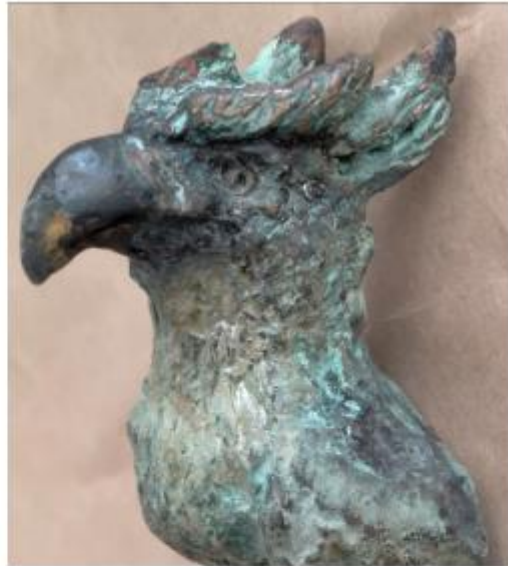
