

Feature artist:

Geoff McGowan (WSA member & printmaker) is travelling overseas and managed to call into the Glasgow Print Studio. Geoff commented that they have a big shop, a large gallery and a huge workshop area -separate space for master printer and artist in residence, archive, lunch /common room, offices, separate areas for relief, etching and screen print and acid rooms, along with:

- Columbian eagle and motorized press in the relief area
- 3 other big etching presses
- large Laser cutter
- lots of big drying racks.

There is an arrangement with the Glasgow Gallery of Modern Art for their artists to use the Glasgow Print Studio facilities, who keep half the print run selling some in their shop and keeping the remainder in , most sold in their shop and a couple kept in their archives.
