Back in 1998 the Waikato Society of Arts had a Gala Exhibition Opening on the 26th of June to celebrate the move from 192 Victoria Street to 120 Victoria Street, the ArtsPost building. With varnished floors still hardening and paint still drying, from renovating this, the dedicated committee managed to successfully open this new space with 3 galleries, a community gallery, a retail space, meeting room and the art school studios all under one roof. We have now been given the opportunity to be back at the ground floor level and finish off what was set up 25 years ago. This will be an arts hub for the community with art classes still being held upstairs and, in the basement print studios, along with the retail space and three galleries operating under the new management of WSA. A new gallery space will be what is currently the i-site office and will be named the 'Ruth Davey gallery', not to overshadow the milestone of Ruth turning 100 on the 15th of December. Upstairs our current art library will be moved into the office/NLG so this is a larger space for community to sit and read our extensive treasure trove of art resources or for meetings and workshops to be run. We are open for business from the 1st of February and will have a soft opening for Members and sponsors at 5.30pm-7pm to celebrate and recognise our 90th year of bringing arts to the Waikato. We would like to thank the Hamilton City Council for giving us this opportunity and look forward to hosting you all next year as we continue to bring you classes, exhibitions, NZ art awards and so much more for the community.
